

Dress Code At A Glance

General Rules

Not allowed

- Blue or Black Jeans
- Cutoffs
- Frayed or torn clothing
- Sports caps and men's hats in the building
- Tank tops for men
- Exposed bathing suits and bare feet in the clubhouse even when going to the restroom or exiting the clubhouse.
- No thongs for women or bikini suits for men

Second Floor

Please see information for specific event. In general jackets are not required unless specified.

R&A Room

- Until 5pm: Casual and sports attire as per above
- After 5pm: Country Club Casual
 - Collared shirts and appropriate shorts and trousers for men unless there is a special event
 - Comparable attire for women

Pool Deck Dining

- Women's and girls wearing swimsuits must wear a cover-up top and bottom
- Men and boys must wear a shirt with sleeves
- Shoes must be worn at all times

Golf, Tennis and Croquet

Traditional dress required. Please refer to handbook for details
